

Notice and Generic Instructions for the Summer Term (June-July 2024)

This is for the information of all concerned that the summer term will commence from **June 10, 2024**. Following are the main key points regarding the summer term:

1. All currently enrolled students of **UG (1st to 4th Year) / PG (1st and 2nd Year) / Ph.D.** can take their backlog courses (E, X, F), Incomplete (I grade) courses in summer term.
2. Above said students can take *improvement course/s* (course/s where existing grade is B/B-/C/C-) in summer term. Students who have graduated in the past five years and want to improve their CGPA can also do so and will have to take prior approval by sending an email in the name of the Director, TIET at ss_a@thapar.edu. They will have to surrender their original degree.
3. Students can opt the courses in summer term in different modes as per the following rules. Mode once selected, will not be allowed to change.

*Marks obtained as 24.9 or equivalent will not be rounded off, so no request will be entertained for the same.

4. The **project based courses** such as *Engineering Design-1, Engineering Design-2, Innovation and Entrepreneurship* or any other project based course offered by any department can be taken up in the summer term in **regular mode** only. The courses such as **Capstone Project, and Project Semester cannot** be taken-up in the summer term.
5. A maximum of 4 courses (including maximum 3 courses in regular mode) can be taken by any student. Maximum of "A-" grade can be awarded in the summer term. No Make-up / I grade will be given for the courses taken in summer term.
6. Faculty can take sessional evaluations during MST and EST weeks to cater the self-study courses/students. No relaxation or lingering will be permissible. Students will not be allowed to take-up any evaluation in online mode. The students may have 2 examinations in a single day. So, no request can be entertained for any kind of date -sheet adjustment.
7. Summer term fee will be INR 15000 per course. This fee is strictly non-refundable and non-adjustable. This is for strict compliance. Students are hereby advised to plan their courses accordingly. *In case any student has submitted the fee for any specific course and that course is not offered by the DoAA office, then fee for that subject will get refunded.*
8. Students have to maintain their attendance (Regular courses) for LTP as per Institute academic rules and regulations.
9. **Please note that course(s) in Summer term will be offered subject to availability of the faculty.**

10. In case a student has improved the grade in a particular course, the same course can't be registered again for improvement. Further, student who has improved his/her grades will not be considered for medal / scholarship / upgradation on the basis of improved grades. Marks / grades obtained only in/during 1st attempt of the course will only be considered for medal / scholarship / upgradation.

Students will apply for summer term till **May 29, 2024 (EOD)** through their respective **web-kiosk account only**. Please browse through Academic Info->Summer Term Registration.

Payment Mode Details

Summer term fee (Rs. 15000/- per course) can be paid using the link <https://forms.eduqfix.com/thapariet/add>. The concerned students will submit the payment details in the application form on the webkiosk.

The summer term forms submitted without the payment proof/details or wrong / misleading payment details, will not be considered.
